Little City Workshop for Early Years

Tuesday 26th February

This visit looks fabulous and is aimed at our nursery and foundation children. This company brings a range of play equipment revolving around vocations.

The nursery session is 9-10am and the EYFS is 10.10-11.10am. All nursery children can attend.

Literacy Day- Thursday 7th <u>March</u>

This day coincides with World Book Day. This year the theme is 'writing a story to share with other children' On Wednesday 6th March, Simon Murray (Author) will be leading a session on writing.

The children can come to school dressed as their favorite literary character and can bring their favourite book into school. They will be allowed to swap their books at the end of the day so please let your child know whether they are allowed to do this. Year 3 and 4 we be sharing a story with the younger children and all children will receive a $\pounds1$ book token on this day.

Curriculum session on Phonics

At the end of this day there will be a curriculum session at 2.15 pm in the Church House for Nursery, Foundation and Year 1 regarding early phonics and reading.

<u>Mathematics Day - Friday 15th</u> <u>March</u>

On this day we will be focusing on money. We will be having sessions with HSBC Bank to support the work we already do on the children's understanding of financial matters

It is also Red Nose Day!

We are asking on this day that your child comes into school dressed in something red and brings in £1. We hope to raise some money for this important event.

Curriculum Session on Maths

There is a second curriculum session at 2.15 pm in the Church House for Year 2, 3 and 4. This will cover the various strategies used to help your child understand more about the craft of manipulating number and learning their times tables.

Entrepreneurial Day – Friday 22nd March

The aim of this day is to open the children's horizons to different careers. In the morning children will visit specific workshops, hopefully led by our parents.

Usually, we attend Church on this day, but this year we are performing our concert in the Church House at 9am & 2.15pm.

This is an enjoyable sponsored event at the Braywood Cricket Ground on the day we break up for half term.

The children run 1 mile around the cricket groups which is approximately 4 laps and friends, grandparents or work colleagues can sponsor the children. The teachers walk the children down for 1pm and afterwards there are refreshments organised by the PTA. The Nursery will not be attending and will need collecting by 2pm

Holidays and lateness

There is a government initiative stressing the importance of children being in school every day. This is so important.

National school attendance has dropped especially after Covid. The expected level of attendance should be 95% and above. These absences are monitored by the Government

As a focus, the office will send out a leaflet to every family where their child's attendance is less than 95% for your information. For your convenience this can also be monitored through eschools.

School closes on Thursday 28th March at 2pm. There is no after school club on this day. We open again on Tuesday 16th April at the usual time.

Our Acorn Nursery Update

Children can come to our Nursery from the age of 3 years for morning or afternoon session

The curriculum in our Nursery supports and enriches the Foundation Stage and children who move from our Nursery to Reception will be very well prepared for this next stage.



To share all the children's learning experiences, we are using the Tapestry Online Platform. This outlines the children's development with photographs of their day. If you have any questions, do please ask. To ensure parents are fully informed we are introducing progress meetings on Mondays and Fridays after school. You will be invited to attend by the Nursery staff.
