#### Extended Curricular Experiences

Pupils have the chance to enhance their physical development and mental wellbeing through numerous extra-curricular opportunities at Braywood.

Visits enable children to extend their learning and enrich their understanding of the topic area. Usually educational visits or invited speakers are part of every term's topic and range from visits to outdoor spaces, museums, theatres, local places of interest and a residential.

We regularly hold theme weeks and special days such as Families into School which enable mums, dads and grandparents to share in the learning experience with their child. These are always well attended and hold a special place in our calendar of events. Curriculum weeks help us to focus on a specific topic area to highlight its importance, for example Literacy Day.

We value the creative and expressive arts and feel it should form a vital experience in every child's development. To encourage this, we ensure that children have an opportunity to engage in a variety of regular creative experiences, meet and work with resident artists, perform on stage or learn to play an instrument.

All children have the opportunity to engage in real life experiences, such as cooking, budgeting or first aid. We have strong links with businesses who visit Braywood to share their experiences and participate in early workshops involving producing products and sales. Physical opportunities across all sports are available, including tournaments and competitions inside and outside school. We are a healthy school and alongside nutritiously balanced meals all children take 2 hours of PE lessons and daily PE bursts.

The staff are very committed to ensuring that there is a wide choice of extra-curricular clubs for children to participate in. There are a wide range of extra-curricular activities organised throughout the year alongside our after-school club.

These include:

Netball, Eco Club, Rugby, Football, Basketball, Athletics, Dance, Gymnastics, Tennis, Sewing, Gardening, Cooking, Art, ICT all of which extend the children's experiences.

Peripatetic music specialists visit the school once a week and our Music teacher offers recorder, singing and piano lessons. Children can experiment with a range of instruments during music lessons and have the opportunity to join in our talent show. All children are part of the Chamber Choir in year 3 and 4 and sing in several festivals. Usually children are involved in Wider Musical Opportunities whereby they can learn to play the violin or cello, guitar or drums. All Year 4 children have swimming lessons at the Windsor Leisure Centre.

We have a 'wild area' where all children participate in forest school activities which fosters skills in team building, problem solving and a love of outdoors.

#### 'Kiss and Drop' & 'Grab and Go'



Our 'Kiss and Drop' operates from 8.20 am to the start of the school day from Monday to Friday at a cost of £1.50 a day and 'Grab and Go' runs from the end of the school day for 20 mins at a cost of £1.00. Parents can pull up outside the Church House for 'Kiss and Drop' and a member of staff will collect their child from the car. Inside the Church House Hall, they will be looked after until it is time for the children to be taken to their individual classrooms. Parents collecting from 'Grab and Go' need to come into the main car park, reverse into an allocated space and their child will be walked out to the car.

### After School Club




