

## KS1 Statutory Assessment Test Comparison Data through the Covid Years

Our school procedures have prioritised high-quality teaching across the curriculum as it is so important that all children have a good start in life and maintain education. The SATS take place in Year 2 and involve an assessment in Reading Writing and Mathematics.

When the DfE did not require an official grade for these children, we still tested the children to ascertain an unofficial assessment benchmark to support the school's assessment procedures.

In 2019 to 2000 95% reached the standards in Reading 89% reached the standards in Writing 95% reached the standards in Mathematics There was no official Government Test, so we did not record the children who exceeded these standards

In 2020 to 2021 92% reached the standards in Reading 88% reached the standards in Writing 88% reached the standards in Mathematics There was no official Government Test so we did not record the children who exceeded these standards.

## In 2021 to 2022

88% reached the standards in Reading, 36% exceeded expected standards 89% reached the standards in Writing, 20% exceeded expected standards 84% reached the standards in Mathematics, exceeded expected standards These results were official Government Test assessments which were moderated for accuracy.

Due to the pandemic, there has been a slight reduction in children reaching the exceeded grade generally because of exposure to the curriculum. The slight fluctuations are generally due to the cohort.
