

Through Covid we have continued with our assessment procedures as we feel that it is important to maintain our assessment procedures.

## In 2019 to 2000

80% our younger children achieved a Good Level of Development which dropped slightly as many children had lost a key period out of school.

## In 2020 to 2021

77% our younger children achieved a Good Level of Development. This dropped as many children had lost 2 periods of time out of school.

## In 2021 to 2022

95% our younger children achieved a Good Level of Development. These standards have risen considerably as these children take advantage of our extensive 'catch-up' procedures.

A Good Level of Development means that they have an overall understanding of the key areas of learning, they are physically aware and have a good level of self-regulation strategies in order to access learning.
