



## Early Years Comparison Data through the Covid Years

Through Covid we have continued with our assessment procedures as we feel that it is important to maintain our assessment procedures.

In 2019 to 2020

**80% our younger children achieved a Good Level of Development which dropped slightly as many children had lost a key period out of school.**

In 2020 to 2021

**77% our younger children achieved a Good Level of Development. This dropped as many children had lost 2 periods of time out of school.**

In 2021 to 2022

**95% our younger children achieved a Good Level of Development. These standards have risen considerably as these children take advantage of our extensive 'catch-up' procedures.**

A Good Level of Development means that they have an overall understanding of the key areas of learning, they are physically aware and have a good level of self-regulation strategies in order to access learning.
